Kindly note that the ECPGR Executive Committee (ExCo), during its recent meeting on 30 May 2016, approved for funding the proposal 'EURISCO Training' 2017. The Steering Committee will have to clear the decision with regard to the partnership in the projects.

Please note that the budget table has been revised, but only moving the budget line "Local organization" from the 'Other actions' section to the 'Meetings' section for administrative purposes. These costs will be reflected in the Letter of Agreement between Bioversity and IPK for the organization of the training workshop in Gatersleben.

Please also note that the partner from Azerbaijan will not be eligible for ECPGR funding until this country complies with ECPGR Rule of Procedure 1.7, related to outstanding membership fees.
